

Planned roadworks and traffic disruptions



Works and events that may affect traffic in the borough.

This bulletin provides advance notice of roadworks in Merton along with in progress works. We recognise that roadworks can cause inconvenience and we hope this information helps to minimise delays and allow you to plan alternative routes or choose more sustainable ways to travel.

A217 London Road / A216 Streatham Road, Mitcham – Multi-way lights / Road Closure

Temporary traffic lights in place at the junction with Locks Lane with a Closure of Locks Lane to enable repairs to a Leaking Gas Main. Continuation of works to enable Gas Main replacement works to be carried out.
