She had been provincial from 1991 - 1997 so would have been Chair of Governors /a Governor in each of your schools. Please keep her in your prayers.

Highlights of the Week

Growth Mindset: The Power of Believing You Can Improve

We all know that students who have a certain mindset, or attitude to learning, are more successful in school and happier in their learning. Leading Psychologist, Speaker and Author, Carol Dweck, summarises it as follows: "In a Growth Mindset, people believe that their most basic abilities can be developed through dedication and hard work. They reject that talent alone creates success — without effort." This [Ted Talk by Carol Dweck](#), whilst it was recorded almost 10 years ago, remains 100% relevant today.

How can parents and carers support?

Carol and other experts say that "Understanding Growth Mindset and then making small, yet significant, changes in the way we talk to young people will have a lasting impact. Praise that emphasises a young person's efforts, actions, and strategies yields greater persistence and better performance over the long term. Praise that focuses on intelligence or talent promotes significantly less persistence and performance."
