It has been another week of significant sporting accomplishment, and we are looking forward to the scheduled under-14 Football final next Wednesday. Come on UHS!

- Amy in Year 8 went to Aland in Finland with Tolworth Gymnastics club to compete in her first international competition. Incredibly, she placed first in the Floor exercises, second in the Uneven Bars and fourth in the vault. An incredible haul at her first attempt and helped her team win the overall Gold medal.
- Success also on the track last weekend, Maia won the 100m U17 Surrey Championship with a huge personal best of 11.69. Maia is now No. 2 in the UK for 100m and hurdles and she currently stands no. 22 in the UK across all age groups for her 100m. Her mum said, 'that warm weather training camp in Jamaica over Easter certainly paid off!' What is even more incredible is that Maia managed to do this alongside her revision for all her GCSEs, which she is sprinting through as well!
- Maria in Year 7 was telling me about her recent swimming successes in the South-East London Regional Championships that took place at the Olympic London Aquatics Centre last weekend. Maria competed across a number of disciplines and had some superb results, including a Silver medal in the 100m Breaststroke.
