Serviam & Social Action; Making A Difference In Our Local Community!



We are so proud of Year 8 for having put their heart and soul into their fundraising for their chosen charities in the *First Give* **Philanthropy project**. Students start working on this special project in Spring Term, and it is taught across PSHEC, Music and RE lessons with the aim to help our students understand about social justice and live out Catholic Social Teaching. Every year, Year 8 forms select a charity they feel strongly about and then sets about creating a plan as to how to best assist them, raising awareness, and money for their chosen charity. This then culminated in the Grand Final held on Friday 2nd May, where each class made a pitch to a panel in order to win an additional £1000 for their charity.

This year the charities selected were; **8 Angela:** Linden Lodge Charitable Trust, **8 Bernadette**: The Ben Kinsella Trust, **8 Catherine**: Refuge, **8 Francis**: Lives Not Knives, **8 Margaret**: Little Village, **8 Teresa**: Merton Faith in Action, and **8 Ursula**: Dons Local Action.

Students worked extremely hard thinking up a variety of ways to support their charities; including many cake sales in the community, tik tok videos to promote awareness, and a staff race which was ticketed - with snacks available at a extra cost, of course!

Each form group then created fantastically persuasive pitches as to why their charities would make the best use of the £1000 prize, which they eagerly presented to judges at the Grand final, displaying their hard work, and dedication to the cause over the past few months. It was a very close call, however after much deliberation from the judges 8 Ursula were deemed winners of the £1000 prize, to help their charity 'Dons Local Action', a food bank charity run by members of AFC Wimbledon. Their powerful presentation really drove home the message of how vital food banks are at this current time, with a catchy jungle and emotive stories.

As a year group, Year 8 raised a grand total of £8,424 funding for all charities involved! Mr Kelly commented; "This is a staggering and truly remarkable figure, smashing all previous records and is testament to the passion and energy for Serviam of all the Year 8s involved. Well done Year 8."
