Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you to the all the parents and carers who have supported their daughters in their extra commitment as part of the cast and crew of the school production Hairspray. I had the pleasure of enjoying the show on Thursday night, which was sensational, and I am really looking forward to the final performance tonight.

Well done to Julia S in 7Angela, this year's Christmas card competition winner. We were inundated with entries, but Julia's really stood out and was unanimously selected by the judging panel for depicting the nativity scene. We also found out this week that two more of our students (in addition to the eight last year) have been successful in securing a place on the national Youth Choirs under the 9-15 and 15-18 age categories. Eleana T in 7A and Eugenia K in 11U came to see me this week to tell me about the experience. Being selected for the national choir is an exceptional achievement so thank you also to Mr Ching for promoting this opportunity.

As the Church celebrates its Jubilee Year in 2025, the Ursulines also mark a significant milestone: the 125th anniversary of the founding of the Roman Union. We celebrated with sweet treats for the school community and a book mark for each student.

#### Highlights of the week

On Wednesday we welcomed a party of significant visitors to the school. Alan Parnum, Regional Director for Education at the DfE, Angela Cox, Director of Education Archdiocese of Southwark, Matthew Crew, DfE, Michea Feely, CEO and other staff from the central team of Sancta Familia all came to our school on Tuesday to meet and have a tour to see the school in action. The meeting went exceptionally well, and they were naturally extremely impressed by our remarkable students.

The Mock Oxbridge Interviews got underway this week, and the students have been working hard to prepare themselves for this academic challenge. Outside of Sixth Form, Years 7 to 10 continue to present in their Oracy assessments - lesson observations and feedback from students indicate that this opportunity is really helping our students develop their public speaking confidence and delivery.

#### Focus areas for next week

The continued focus on improved attendance remains until the final day of this term. In addition, we are asking students to engage in our Advent Serviam Appeals. Students are being asked to support, contribute, and participate in the Christmas gift appeal from the Catholic Children's Society and in the Food bank donations to the Dons local Action group. 


