Dear Parents and Carers,

As the Red Weather warnings are now extended to Friday 26th June 11pm, the following weather adjustments have also been extended.

We have scheduled a staggered end to the school day during Period 5 on Friday to ensure that students are not being dismissed at the same time, thus reducing waiting time for public transport. Lunch service will be available in the school dining room for all year groups before transit home.

On Friday 26th June:

1. Year 7 and Year 9 students will be dismissed during Period 5 after they have been registered, at 1:00pm.
Year 7 students will use the Key Stage 4 bus stop at the bottom of Crescent Road (Worple Road)
Year 9 will use the assigned Key Stage 3 bus stop further along Worple Road (Arterberry Road)
2. Year 10 and Year 8 will be dismissed at 1:20pm by their Period 5 Teachers
Usual allocated bus stops for both Years.
3. Year 12: no lessons Period 5. School will end at 12:50pm.

Additional considerations:

1. PE lessons have been adjusted. No lessons will take place at Morley Park on Friday. At break times students are being directed to areas of shade.
2. All after school clubs and interventions have been postponed/cancelled.
3. Uniform. Students have the option of wearing their PE kit or school uniform for travel to and from school and throughout the day. (Hot weather school uniform allowances). No alternatives to school-approved uniform items will be permitted.

Once again a reminder to all students to have with them a bottle of water, suncream and a hat for head coverage when outside and travelling.

The red weather warning ends on Friday night. **As of Monday 29th June, normal warm weather considerations and timetable will resume:** this means that students are not required to wear school jumpers or blazers, shirts must be tucked in and socks may be rolled down. Lessons at Morley Park will resume. Students can no longer come to school in their PE kit.
