## 2019 Cultural Exchange with Ursuline Academy Dallas

Here at the Ursuline we are extremely proud to be part of a global network of Ursuline Schools; a sisterhood of staff, students and alumnae with whom we share our Catholic faith and the values set out by Angela Merici. This Community works together to support the learning and achievement of Ursuline Students across the world. Our annual exchange with the staff and students of Dallas Academy is a unique opportunity for students to benefit from this powerful partnership. Students who have taken part in this exchange in the past have found it a hugely enriching and confidence building experience, meeting students and staff, learning together, living with a Texan family and hosting a Texan student.

The trip is open to students currently in Years 9 and 10 and I am writing to invite your daughter to apply to take part in this exchange. Unfortunately, numbers are limited to 14 students. Details of the application process are below.

#### Proposed dates for 2019 (subject to final confirmation)

- Students from Dallas Academy hosted by UHS students: Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> June Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2019
- UHS students to Ursuline Academy Dallas: Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> October Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> October 2019 (an overnight flight, arriving back on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup>)

#### **Student Application**

To be considered, your daughter's effort in school work and behaviour must be excellent, she must also write a word processed application letter (one A4 side maximum) which includes the following points

- A description of her personality and interests
- Her reasons for applying to take part in the exchange and why she should be selected
- What she would bring to the exchange to benefit others
- A description of her Serviam commitment and activities this year.

\*\* Please note that the majority of people travelling to America will require an electronic visa (an ESTA) and that it is **your** responsibility to organise your daughter's visa requirements in good time for the trip. You will also need to ensure that your daughter's passport has enough 'time' left on it – our airline company will not accept a passport which has less than 6 months left on (i.e. an expiry of March 2020 or later is needed for the trip). If your daughter requires a new passport for the trip please organise this as soon as possible; all passport details must be with our airline by Monday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019, if you cannot provide passport details by this time than an extra fee will be payable by yourselves.\*\*

## Costs and other key arrangements

The provisional cost is £1,140 subject to both flight costs and full uptake (14 students) of the trip. The exchange includes:

- Travelling to/from school by mini-bus to/from Heathrow airport
- Comprehensive travel insurance
- Cultural activities and trips in Dallas for example to the JFK museum, school and Serviam activities
- Some of the cultural activities that the Dallas girls undertake whilst in the UK e.g. trips in London
- All meals and accommodation with Dallas families whose daughters attend the Ursuline Academy
- All meals in school and during cultural activities.
- The trip does not include pocket money and we recommend a maximum of £300 (approximately \$400) per student.
- In June 2019 the students from Dallas Academy will be visiting us, and you will be asked to host one of them. This is a strong element of the exchange, but if hosting is an issue, please indicate so on your reply slip. The guest students need not to have a spare room, they may share a room with another girl in your family, but they must have their own bed.

## To confirm your interest and permission:

Please return the reply slip below to myself, along with your daughter's application form.

If your daughter is been selected for the trip, you will be asked to pay a non-refundable deposit of £250 by Friday 29th March. You are required to pay for this trip via your ParentPay account.

If you have forgotten your ParentPay login, please visit their website (www.parentpay.com) and click on "Forgotten password" in the Account login section. Should this cause you any difficulty, please contact Salvina Barcellona <u>salvina.barcellona@ursulinehigh.merton.sch.uk</u> in the Finance office who will be able to assist you with this. Please note that this is a voluntary trip. Therefore, if insufficient funds are raised, then the trip may have to be cancelled or the price amended.
