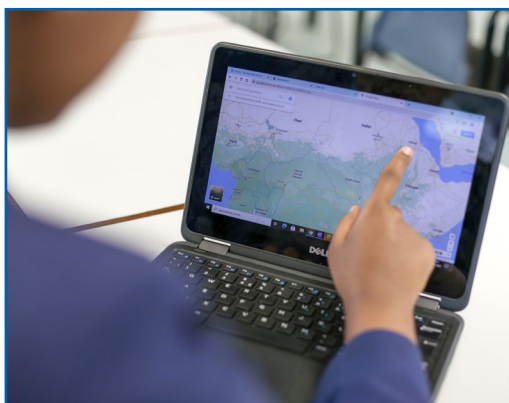


Foreword
