## **Chaplain Update**

This year our theme is 'Insieme', which links with all the Ursuline schools in the UK through the Ursuline Education Community. At our St Ursula Masses, the reflection focused on Sr Dorothy Strang who worked so tirelessly for the protection of the Amazon and its people within, giving up her life for the cause. Sr Dorothy teaches us how the destruction of the planet effects the poorest communities first, she teaches us the importance of protecting the weak and vulnerable This encouraged each of us to think about the changes we can make in our lives for the good of others and the planet.



A highlight of this half term was the Year 11 Retreat 'Dare to Dream'. On the Retreat we were joined by the Daughters of Divine Charity who were on the TV show 'Bad Habits'. They shared their personal faith journey's with the students and encouraged them to 'Dare to Dream'. In the closing reflection students were asked to reflect on the prayer of John Henry Newman and think of one way they will put their faith into action!
