Dear Parents/Carers

The Prime Minister announced on 27 November the temporary introduction of new measures as a result of the Omicron variant, including updated guidance for schools.

Face coverings

- Face coverings should be worn in communal areas in all settings by staff, visitors, and students unless they are exempt.
- Students should continue to wear face coverings on public transport, unless they are exempt
- Students should provide their own clean face covering for each day of school.

Tracing close contacts and isolation

- Close contacts in schools continue to be identified by NHS Test and Trace. Schools are not tasked with identifying or informing close contacts.
- Young people who have been identified as a close contact of someone with COVID-19 **should** continue to attend school as normal.
- If applicable, close contacts will be contacted by NHS Test and Trace, informed and advised to take a PCR test. We strongly encourage all individuals to follow this advice.

Omicron Variant: changes to isolation rules

- Any suspected or confirmed close contacts of the Omicron variant will be asked to isolate for 10 days regardless of vaccination status or age. You will be contacted directly and told to isolate.
- The school will provide access to online learning for those students who are self-isolating as a close contact only

Twice-Weekly home testing

Your daughter has been provided with lateral-flow tests and **should be testing twice a week** (we recommend Sunday and Wednesday evenings).

- If the result is negative, then no action is required, and your daughter can continue to attend school as normal.
- If the test is positive, then you must take your daughter for a PCR test immediately. Your daughter must self-isolate until the result of this PCR test has been returned.
