Re: Return to school Year 10

We are very much looking forward to welcoming your daughter back to school.

Year 10 Covid Testing arrangements

Year 10 will be tested on Wednesday 10th March. Students will be tested and once the result is recorded students will return home. The time for your daughter to arrive is below.

Students will arrive via the Dorothy Kazel entrance and will be shown to the Main Hall where they will wait to be tested in the Sports Hall. If your daughter tests positive we will call you to come and collect her. Students will need to be in full school uniform and bring a drink and a book to read while they wait for their test and result. Masks will be worn at school where social distancing is not possible. This will temporarily include classrooms until Easter. This is following Government recommendations. I recognise not all parents will be in agreement and I recognise the disadvantages. On balance however I am mindful of the well-being of all students and especially of those students with underlying health issues. The [Face coverings in education](#) document states - "The World Health Organisation published a statement on 21 August about children and face coverings. They now advise that "children aged 12 and over should wear a mask under the same conditions as adults, in particular when they cannot guarantee at least a 1-metre distance from others and there is widespread transmission in the area." Students will be tested three times in all. The second and third tests will take place during school time on Monday 15th and Thursday 18th. Thereafter students will be given the tests to complete at home twice weekly.

Year 10 will be registered at our testing centre and you will receive notification of the result via a text on your mobile phone.

Year 10 will return to school on Thursday 11th March at the normal time at 8.35am. Students will have time to reconnect with their tutor and routines and there will be no homework during their first week.

If you have not consented to testing then your daughter will return to school at the same time as the whole cohort on Thursday 11th March.

There will be no on-line lessons for students on testing day.

Travel to and from school must follow Government guidelines. Could we ask you to remind your daughters regarding the social distancing and the use of masks on public transport.
