We are pleased to inform you that the Ursuline High School sports day is coming soon at the above venue. Registers will be taken at the track and unauthorised absences will be recorded. All students are expected to make their own way to the above address and arrive promptly on time. The most efficient way to get to the venue from the Wimbledon area is via the 131 bus. This bus route stops outside the ground (see map) & you can catch the 131 from Worple Road at the normal school bus stops going towards Kingston.

Please ensure that your daughter is equipped with the following items:-

- **Full Ursuline PE Kit- No other colour hoodies, jumpers or tracksuit bottoms allowed.** Students must arrive/leave in their full PE Kit. Cheerleaders must bring their costume to change into. Navy blue **Ursuline tracksuit** can also be worn if that is what you have instead of the skirt or navy leggings under your skirt.
- Packed lunch/water (some refreshments will also be available at venue to purchase).
- Sun cream/hat or cap - check the weather on 30th June before you leave home.
- Yr12 can wear their own suitable sportswear.

Please make sure that your daughter is wearing PE kit uniform only as she will be sent back to school if she does not have the correct PE kit on. Students will be dismissed from the track after the final presentations have been awarded at approximately 12.30pm. Parents are most welcome to support this event but cannot be in the student areas and must remain in the parent's area located near the finish line. If your daughter is being picked up from the venue you must inform her tutor in advance so she can be ready to leave with you. A copy of the events timetable will be available on the school website and will be emailed to students.


