Headteacher's Weekly Roundup Summer B Week 1

We welcomed all the students back to school this week for the final run of this academic year. Year 8 have been exemplary in their application and effort in preparing and performing in their end of year exams. Well done and they deserve a good rest this weekend.

On Thursday we had an unscheduled Fire alarm at the start of lesson one. The students in the school were exceptional in their response and evacuation. The timing of this was unfortunate as it coincided with the 9am start time of public examinations in A' Levels and GCSEs. Thankfully, the whole school community of students and staff were 100% focused on the students in their exams and this reflected the ethos and culture of the school focusing on helping others.

I was delighted to hear the recollections of the students in Year 9 and 10 who went to Largenté on the French students exchange programme: staying with families, experiencing French school and getting an in-depth cultural experience. The highlight was the trip to Lourdes which was an excellent lead into the theme of 2024-25 being the Year of Pilgrimage in the Church. It appears we are in a period of peak exchange as we also welcomed the students from the Ursuline Academy in Dallas, USA. This exchange benefits not only the students directly involved in hosting and participating but also all the students in the school who get to meet and know Ursuline students from across the world.

Highlights of the Week

Attendance this week across all year groups has been excellent, so thank you to parents and carers in supporting this most important priority for your children's education.

I met one of the students this week who attended the HAF programme we offered over half-term and she was so effusive about the experience. 30 students were led by staff at school, there was a boat trip on the Thames, a visit to the cinema and then all participants enjoyed a meal in a restaurant together. We are really fortunate to have the staff in school to ensure that students get these exceptional cultural enrichment experiences in holiday times.

Focus areas for next week

Students are being asked to be much more considerate about how they leave their belongings down before entering the Dining Hall. Students in a rush to get to the front of queues at break times are not being careful or considerate in how they do this and bags are being dropped or dumped with little consideration either for the contents and resources contained inside the bags or where they are being dropped and this impacts on others. We have spoken about this specifically in assemblies and tutor time. Students who leave bags in an unsafe place, such as a doorway (trip hazard) will have them removed and sanctions issued.
