We said goodbye to our Dallas exchange students as they returned home to Texas after a fantastic 10 days experiencing life in London and also being in our school. Thank you to everyone who opened their homes and looked after our guests and to staff students, parents and carers who arranged all the visits and made them feel so welcome. These exchanges are invaluable in understanding and appreciating our shared global ethos as an Ursuline school committed to the values of Serviam.

In another busy week for cultural enrichment on Tuesday 11th June, KS5 French students took part in a visit to South Kensington for a cultural afternoon at the French Institute. They then went on to watch a screening of 'Here' at the French Cinéma Lumière. On Thursday 13th June Sociology students visited the Buddhist Temple in Wimbledon and some Year 12s visited Surrey University to get a taste of what it's like to be a student at university. Mr Cunliffe, our school Chaplain, brought a delegation to the CCE Conference in St Mellitus College with a focus on 'Student Driven Leadership.' Students from Year 7 to Year 10 involved in this programme had an excellent experience of how students can lead for change with a focus on ethical and moral leadership.
