Headteacher's Weekly Roundup Autumn B Week 3

Well done to all the Year 13 who have been receiving their feedback from their mocks and using this learning to make the necessary adjustments to their work. The progress is really reflected in the remarkable outcomes emerging.

The feedback from the observations of the oracy assessments taking place this term in Years 7 to 10 has indicated excellence in preparation and delivery. This value of investing time in the development and mastering of this critical 'soft' skill will no doubt leave a lasting impact on the students.

On Tuesday, we held the Hustings for Head Girls. This was a shortlist of applicants making speeches to the assembled Sixth Form and a selection of Year 11 students, constituting an audience of over 400 people. Brilliant speeches and delivery captivated the audience; voting was exceptionally tight in the race to make the next round. The highest votes enter the final round of interviews for the positions in the next couple of weeks. I was watching MasterChef one evening this week and I was struck by how difficult it must be to make the decision about who doesn't go through. We will now have the same challenge this week in selecting from this significant field. Well done to all applicants and best of luck for the next round in the process.

That brings the total number of our students in the NYC to eight, which is an amazing achievement for any school.
