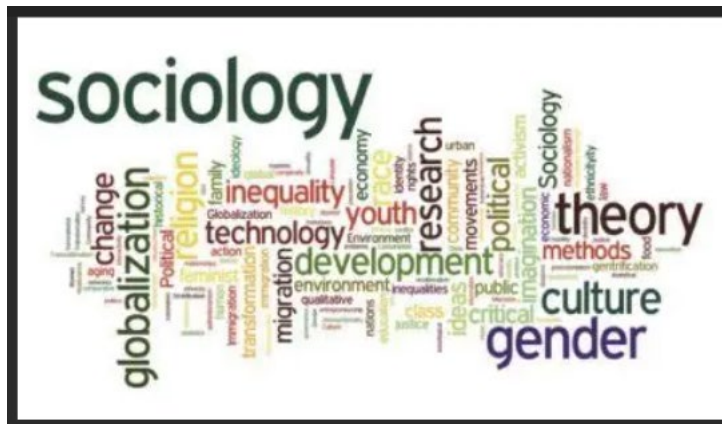

## Why study Sociology?

Studying Sociology at both GCSE and A Level gives students a better understanding of contemporary UK society. In particular we gain an understanding of inequalities and how and why society functions as it does.

## Our Aims at Ursuline High School

## What Sociology qualifications do we offer at the school?

### GCSE Sociology

Following the AQA specification, students have 3 lessons per week. Topics include Education, The family, Crime and Deviance and Social Stratification. Formal assessment consists of 2 exams taken in June of Year 11.

### A-Level Sociology

Following the AQA specification, students have 5 lessons per week and independent study periods. Topics include; Crime and Deviance, Education, Research Methods, Beliefs and Families and Households. Formal assessment consists of 3 exams taken in June of Year 13.

### How can I help my daughter if she gets stuck with homework?
