# Headteacher's Weekly Roundup 2025-2026 - Autumn B, Week 2

Dear Parents/Carers

A busy, full week of school, has helped all students back into their routines. Despite the change to more unsettled weather, our students continue to display great energy and enthusiasm, positively engaging in lessons. Assessment cycles are in full swing as Year 13s completed their Mocks and Year 11s are sitting their Mock Language orals for the December series so flash cards are appearing everywhere! T Level Science and Year 11 Health and Social Care have also been going through a gruelling week of assessment.

On Tuesday, we formally recognised the end of the transition period for our new Year 7 students at our annual Commissioning Service. They promised to uphold the values of the school, to support each other and to live out Serviam and were presented with their school badges. A very proud moment for parents, carers and staff. On Wednesday, the Head Girl (& Boy) Team Hustings took place in the main hall with 12 students making it through to that phase. Voting has been completed and the results of those making it through to the final selection stage, the interview, will be released next week. Congratulations to all the students running in this tightly contested role.

### Highlights of the week

We welcomed back our students returning from the PGL Football and Netball residential weekend of competitions. Remarkably, two of our teams made it through to the grand final of the netball competition sweeping aside all other schools. So, it was a final consisting of a Year 11 UHS Team and a Year 10 UHS team: the stakes were high! Year 10 walked away as winners after a tightly contested final; they get all the bragging rights and house points!

### Focus areas for next week

The school is looking very closely at sporadic, occasional absence patterns. The Year 7 attendance is back over 97% this half term with just 8 students reporting absent with illness. We also had exceptionally low absences in Year 13 and also in Year 11. It is therefore significant that 21 students in Year 8, 30 in Year 9, 31 in Year 10, and 19 in Year 12 were absent for at least one day this half term. These absence rates are unacceptable and out of step with Year 7, 11 and 13. Sporadic absence has a significant impact on progress. Parents and carers must work with the school to ensure full attendance and avoid unnecessary absence through minor ailment. Heads of Year will be following up with each of these students.
