Dear Parents/Carers

Having been out from school at the Southwark Archdiocese Headteachers Conference in Ashford this week, it was great being back in school today to see the excitement building towards the school production of 'Hairspray.' The set arrived at 7am this morning and lots of staff came down to help get it all in ready for the weekend rehearsals. Archbishop Wilson led a reflection to the Headteachers gathered at the conference on Thursday and I was struck by the message from morning prayers "What you are is God's gift to you, what you become is your gift to God." I am sorry to report that the School Production is now SOLD OUT. With two daytime and two evening performances scheduled for next week, the students are primed once again to produce one of the academic year highlights.

I was pleased to hear that they have been invited to Parliament to meet with our local MP, Mr Paul Kohler, to discuss their concerns about climate change. They wrote emails to Mr Kohler as one of our CAFOD Live Simply Award Actions and he has forwarded their emails to The Chief Executive of Merton Council and The Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero, Ed Miliband. There will be a further update once their visit to Parliament has taken place.

They brought him with them to school, and we were able to identify him after contacting his school. The police had already been alerted, his parents were frantically looking for him, and everything was put right by these responsible and kind students. Well done girls and thank you.
