Headteacher's Weekly Roundup 2025-2026 - Autumn A, Week 3

Dear Parents/Carers

After a damp start to the term, we welcomed the sun ahead of the weekend in school with all students taking the opportunity to gather outside at breaks and enjoy the last throes of summer. Main school and Sixth Form enrichment activities got underway this week, significantly on Tuesday with the first session of the Oxbridge programme and with the visit of James Ryan (Ursuline Links Director) to speak with the Year 12s to sign up to this fantastic programme involving Service in Action. Further Form retreats took place involving Year 7 and Year 8 Forms and this has clearly been impactful judging by the quality of the feedback in reviews. One Year 7 wrote "before this retreat I've always tried to fit in and survive, so now I know how to kind of shine and stand out because it's good to let people see that light".

Highlights of the week

We are very proud of our year 13 students who completed the Ursuline Global Scholars' Programme this week with presentations before a panel of judges (the Director of the Ursuline Education Network, Peggy McCormick-Platz, Mr Adam and Mr Glavina.) This is the first year we have run the programme following the model set up by the Ursuline Education Network at Ursuline schools in the United States. To complete the programme, the students need to complete a 5000 word essay, take part in school leadership, serve in the community and qualify in cultural literacy. It is a demanding programme and the students did incredibly well. Well done to all of you.

Focus areas for next week

We have altered the arrival arrangements at school in the morning by redirecting Sixth Form students to the Crescent Road Car Park gates for entrance and exit from school. Letters to year groups affected have been distributed explaining the reasons for this decision. We are asking KS4 students who use the Downs entrance to be considerate of other pedestrians and not to impede other children or families with push chairs in sharing the space.

Signing up for Clubs and Enrichment Activities – if your child hasn't already signed up for a club, please encourage them to do so - we want to see each student signed up to at least one club. Clubs are a great way of building new skills and making friends. Enrichment - Ursuline High School

Reminder that all students need to proceed directly home in uniform following the agreed route. Students must not congregate or visit shops or retail outlets. Students have been taking the opportunity to discuss with their teachers how to respond to stranger danger or inappropriate approaches outside of school.
