It was fantastic to so many families coming to visit our 2025 Open Events for Year 5 families (Year 7 entry, September 2027). With Over 1000 visitors being guided by over 450 students. This incredible demand will need to be followed up with additional opportunities to visit the school. We are thrilled to report that the school looked and felt incredible.
