Drama is a highly successful department at Ursuline High School at Key Stage 3 (7 to 9) Key Stage 4 (10-11) and Key Stage 5 (12-13).

Our exam results are testament to a department that has been recognised by the exam board for above average results.

We have two fully equipped Drama Studios used primarily for in-house teaching, performance and examination spaces, where students practice, watch and critique their own and other students' work.

We have close links with Old Vic Outreach programme, National Youth Theatre and locally with Lantern Arts Centre, thus providing students with affordable access to live theatre.

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The Drama department seeks to foster leadership, a sense of community, artistic integrity, intellectual expertise, and the best professional values to serve students in their chosen profession.
