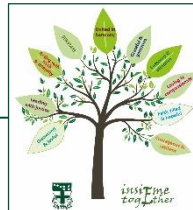
Instructions

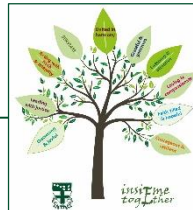

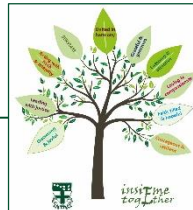


Photo competition
