Students start working on this special project in spring term. Each Year 8 form voted to select a charity they are passionate about, they then spent a significant amount of time researching and getting to know the charities to find out their aims and pain points, before setting about creating a plan to attempt to raise money for them, and create further awareness of their cause. All with the aim to potentially win their charity £1000 in the **First Give Grand Final**!

This year the charities selected were **Angela**: **Lives not Knives**, **Bernadette**: **Thrive**, **Catherine**: **STEM 4**, **Francis**: **Arts and Homelessness International**, **Margaret**: **Care Support Merton**, **Teresa**: **SVP (New Malden)**, and **Ursula**: **The Royal Marsden**. Students spent a considerable amount of time fundraising, ranging from bake sales to extra chores and sponsored runs. The eagerly anticipated **Grand Final** was held this half term in our school hall. A panel of judges (including the **Mayor of Merton**; *Councillor Joan Henry*) were treated to some fantastically persuasive presentations regarding the 7 form groups fundraising work over the past few months. The students spoke on why their chosen charity would benefit from the sum of money and how they would use it to make a difference, there were even catchy charity raps for extra omph! It was a close call, however after much deliberation from the judges **8 Francis** were deemed winners, and their charity **Arts and Homelessness International** was awarded the £1000 prize. There are no losers however, as Year 8 raised a total of over £8000 for their charities overall, a truly wonderful achievement! We were also delighted to here that the charities really touched students hearts and they want to continue to spread awareness regarding their charities in the future! Great to hear!
