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

# LESSON TOPICS: AUTUMN B TERM

#### **RE Programme**

Year 7; students will work on their extended writing, 'Jesus was just a man.'They will also start their course on 'Who is Jesus?' In this unit they will consider historical Jesus, Jesus in the Gospels, Islam and Judaism views of Jesus. Students will also attend an Advent service.

Year 8; students will explore Jesus as the New Covenant. They will particularly consider the key questions: how did Jesus establish the new covenant? The exploration will include the festivals of Advent, Christmas, Lent, Holy Week and Easter.

Year 9; students will will explore the meaning and significance of prayer for religious believers; they will explain different types of prayers: Adoration; praise, forgiveness, petition and intercession. Students explain the importance of various aids to prayer in Christianity and other religion.

Year 10; students will will explore Catholic Church teachings on conflict and peace. They will consider Biblical perspectives on violence and bullying; forgiveness and reconciliation, justice; just war theory, the role of religion in conflicts in the 21st century; terrorism; torture, radicalisation and martyrdom; conflict resolution and peace-building

Year 11; students will complete the topic of the Church and the Kingdom of God the start consolidation and revisions in preparation for Mock examinations.

## **PSHEC Programme**

#### Year 7 to focus on;

Identity and multicultural community, Equalities—protected characteristics-introduction, age and sexism, Understanding self and other around you.Positive relationships, bullying and Discrimination. Sexual Harassment and online safety. Personal Awareness and Safety —making appropriate choices. Healthy relationships.

#### Year 8 to focus on;

Forming and maintaining Relationships. Equalities – protected characteristics. Sexual Harassment and Violence. Prevent non violence/ antiwar protests and Terrorist agendas. Positive Mental Health. Money laundering. Government Laws. Personal Hygiene. Anti-bullying week.

## Year 9 to focus on;

Equalities – protected characteristics. FGM. Positive Mental Health. Sexual Harassment, Positive Relationship. Prevent Duty, Cultural Diversity, Personal Awareness and Safety. Domestic Violence. Antibullying.

## Year 10 to focus on;

Equalities – protected characteristics introduction, age and sexism. Sexual Harassment and online safety. Positive relationships. Safe travel. Personal Awareness and Safety – making appropriate choices. Drugs and alcohol. Anti-bullying. Domestic Violence. Prevent Duty. Health decisions.
