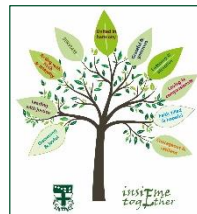


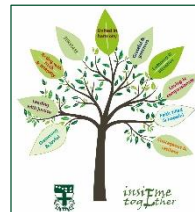

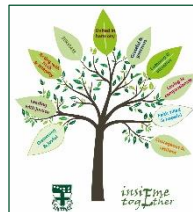


# Year Group Bubble

# Transport

- Crescent Road and The Downs are only to be used for walking. No cars will be permitted to drop students off or pick them up.
- If students get the tram, train or tube, then they need to walk from and to the stations in Wimbledon or Raynes Park.
- Year 8-13 students will not be permitted to board a bus on Worple Road.
- Only Year 7 students will be permitted to get a bus from Worple Road at the end of the day.
- Y7 students travelling with siblings will need to wait for their sibling in the Hall at the end of the day before travelling home.

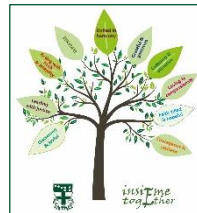

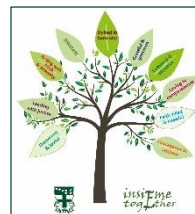

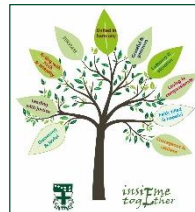


# First day back: 3<sup>rd</sup> September

Lessons will start on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September.

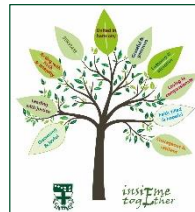


# Recovery Curriculum

- moving forward and Hope



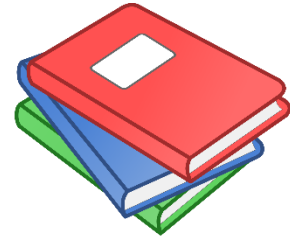
# Grouping

Year Group	Detail

11	No changes will be made, unless there are exceptional circumstances.

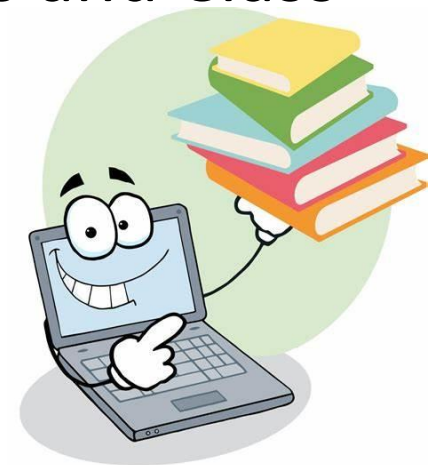
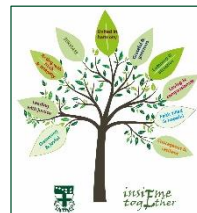
# Teaching and Learning
